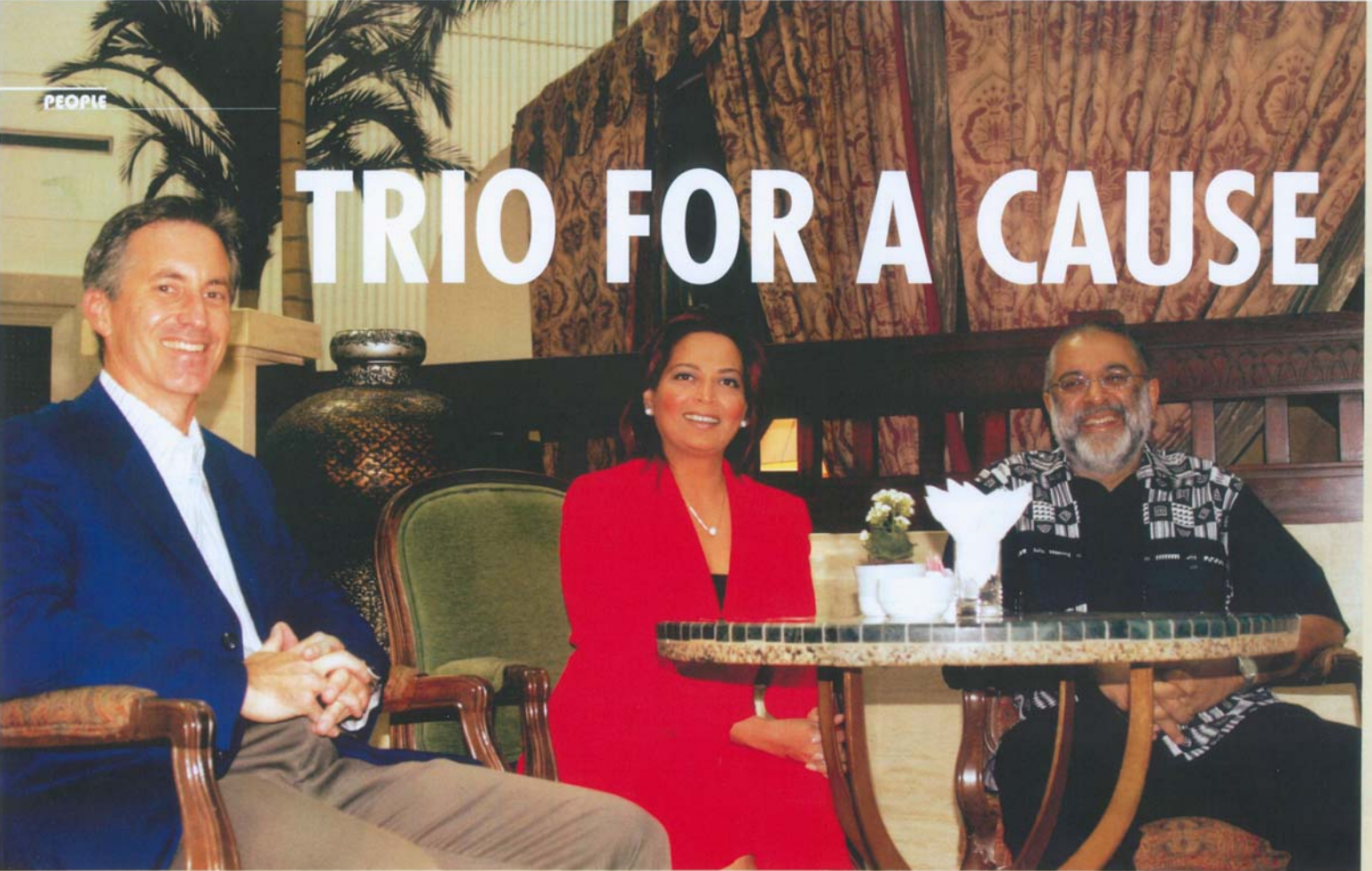


TRIO FOR A CAUSE
